





1. The licence application should be accompanied by the plans in quadruplicate, referred to at Paragraph 4 of the application form and newspaper containing public notice. This shall be in the form set out hereunder:

2. A period of more than two weeks shall not have elapsed between publication of the above notice and the making of the relevant application.
3. A fee of €126 shall be paid to Cavan County Council by the applicant in respect of an application for a licence.
4. Licensing of existing plant under the Air Pollution Act, 1987 (Licensing of Industrial Plant Regulations 1988 is required from 01/03/1989 in the case of the classes outlined in the first schedule of the Regulations (see attached list).
5. Licensing controls will apply to all processes and emissions within the entire plant, that is, all emissions to the atmosphere from the factory premises, even those not associated with emissions under the classes on the list referred to in No. 4.
