Notice is hereby given that Cavan County Council proposes to carry out the following works at Gartanoul and Derinish Beg, Killykeen, Co Cavan.

- **Upgrade of existing pedestrian bridge to include replacement of the existing timber structure and the installation of a temporary modular unit to include toilet facilities and retail space at Killykeen Forest Park.**

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, during public opening hours at the Planning Office, Farnham Centre Cavan Town and the Cavan-Belturbet Municipal District Office, Church Street, Ballyconnell, **by appointment only**, up to and including the **22nd of March 2022**. Details of proposed development are also available for inspection at www.cavancoco.ie/part-8.

Submissions or observations with respect to the proposed development, dealing with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area in which the development will be situated, may be made in writing to Forward Planning Section, Farnham Centre, Farnham Street Cavan **before 4pm on 5th April 2022**.

The development has been the subject of an Appropriate Assessment screening in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Article 250(1) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended. The Appropriate Assessment screening concluded that the proposed development would not be likely to give rise to significant or indeterminate impacts on any Natura 2000 site.

The proposed development is not of a class set out under Schedule 5 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended, and does not require Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).
