MEMBERS' ITEMS – MAY MEETING

12.1 Councillor Clifford Kelly

That Cavan County Council provide an update on the North South Interconnector.

12.2 Councillor Shane P. O'Reilly

To ask the General Manager and Clinical Lead Manager of the Cavan/Monaghan Hospital Group to attend a meeting of Cavan County Council to discuss public issues of Care and Operational Procedures at Cavan General Hospital.

12.3 Councillor Shane P. O'Reilly

To request a full update and a presentation from Children's Health Ireland (CHI) to be delivered at Cavan County Council regarding the timelines and progress on the National Children's Hospital.

12.4 Councillor Brendan Fay

That Cavan County Council calls on the Minister for Finance (the Tánaiste) and the Taoiseach to abolish the Universal Social Charge (USC). This Council notes that the USC was brought in at a time of financial crisis and believes it is now time to put money back into the pockets of workers.
